The Celebrity Xcel cruise is approaching very soon and 28 are on the manifest to travel to the port on the bus. There is a \$20 surcharge for each since we did not recruit 36 on the cruise.

**The next step** in preparing for your cruise is to go online to set up an account. You will need your booking number (which is on your cruise confirmation), ship and sail date. Please go to and click on "Sign In" on the upper right side then click on "Create an Account." Complete all required information. If you have a problem, please contact Celebrity at 800-963-0311.

Shore excursions are available and can be booked online at this time by going to [www.celebrity.com](http://www.celebrity.com). If you need help, you can contact Celebrity help desk for excursion information 877-200-2897. Shows will be available on the day that you board.

When you board, a charge account will be established in your name. Cash is not used on the ship during the cruise for any transactions (except the casino). Purchases onboard will be charged to your account. Customary gratuities of \$18.00 per person per day will automatically be added to your shipboard account (\$18.50 for Concierge and Aqua Class). The final billing can be paid with a credit card, traveler's check or cash. No personal checks are accepted.

The dress code is relaxed which is "casual chic" and formal attire is not required. Dress slacks and collared shirts can be worn. Shorts are not acceptable in the dining room for dinner.
